Notable Shifts:

- Addition of Math Lab and Communications Lab, with a range of modalities, to meet the needs of all learners.
- Equitable “Explorations” for all students. In addition to PE/Sports, Art, and Music, options for the required 'exploratory classes' will include speech, agriculture, family and consumer sciences, industrial technology, world languages, and computer literacy (MO requirements).
- High quality before-school and after-school options.
- Implementation strategy to ensure fidelity of program components and to provide students who are new to our program the opportunity to adjust to both the 'newness' of middle school and the 'newness' of CWC programming. It will also ensure that enough time and focus is placed on math and ELA to ensure students achieve grade level proficiency.
