NWEA (Northwest Evaluation Association) is a global not-for-profit organization offering educational products and services: they collaborate with those who share our belief that education should serve all students.

The NWEA assessment tool, Measures of Academic Progress® (MAP®) creates a personalized assessment experience by adapting to each student's learning level—precisely measuring student progress and growth for each individual.

At CWCKC, students will be assessed on the NWEA MAP (ELA and Math) three times per year. The first assessment window occurred between Monday, Sep. 13 and Friday, Sep. 30. This allowed for multiple practice sessions for each student as well as shortened testing windows to adapt to the developmental needs of our K-1st graders.
